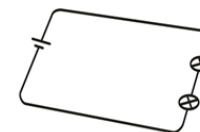
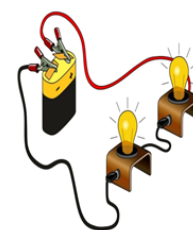

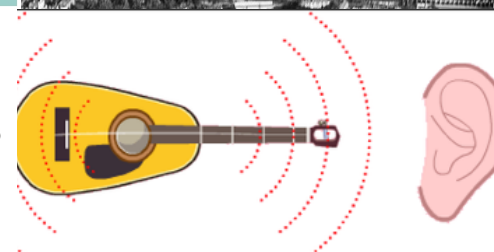

THIS TERM, YOU WILL LEARN...

English	To write a persuasive leaflet, a narrative and a factual report.
Maths	To round and compare decimals. To compare, estimate and solve problems with money. To read, write and convert time. To identify , compare and order angles. To present and interpret data using line graphs. To plot and describe positions using coordinates. Pupils must know all times tables (up to 12 x 12) by the end of Year 4. There is a <u>statutory test in June: Multiplications Table Check for all pupils in Year 4 in the UK.</u>
Science	To construct electrical circuits. To know how sounds are made and notice patterns.
History	To know about the local history of Fulham.
Geography	To know geographical features of Asia.
DT	To use circuits to make night lights.
PE	Lessons will continue with our specialist P.E. teacher.
Music	Listen and appraise songs by the Beatles
Computing	To understand the negative and positive things about using technology To be confident in creating programs for games.
PSHE	The children will learn about building positive, healthy relationships and coping positively with change.

- *Electrical circuits play an important role in day-to-day life. Why might you agree?*
- *Hearing is one of the most important senses. Do you agree or disagree? Explain why in detail.*

KNOWLEDGE ORGANISERS

A knowledge organiser is a document prepared by the class teacher, that contains key facts and information that children need to have a basic knowledge and understanding of a topic. Most knowledge organisers will include: the essential facts about the topic, usually laid out in easily digestible chunks.

Talk through the knowledge organiser at the beginning of the topic, asking the children what information has sparked their interest, and if they have any questions. Use the information for quick retrieval questions to test at home.

The final term is filled with lots of new learning as well as special events so please continue to support your child in completing their home-learning to a high standard, as this will help them practise learning they have already completed in class. There is a high expectation on knowing times tables facts, spellings and reading every day as it is these skills which supports them greatly in class.
