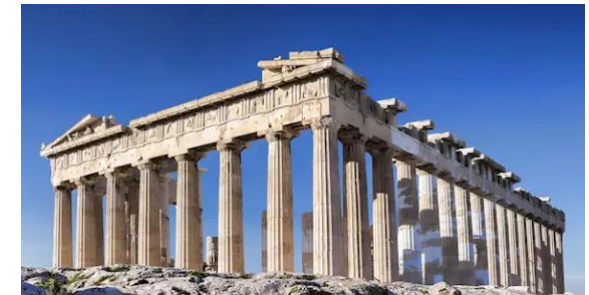
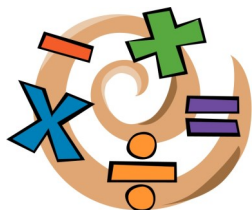

## HOW CAN MY PARENT HELP ME?

Please continue to help your child to practise their spelling and times tables every day.

Reading: It is so important that you listen to your child every day. You can read a reading book together, you could read the news on your phone, you can spot words whilst out shopping and even record interesting words found. The more they read, the more interesting and fluent their writing will become. When you read with your child, to support their comprehension, please ask them questions about their book. Every child has a Bedrock login. Bedrock is designed to develop your child's vocabulary.

Maths: 'Hit the button' (easy to find via Google) is a fun, free interactive game online which allows children to practice times tables and number bonds. Please encourage your child to play in their spare time as it will help them in all other areas of maths. Every pupil also has a Timetable Rockstar login which is a fan-

## THIS TERM, YOU WILL LEARN...

English	We are writing a fable, a persuasive travel leaflet and a factual report.
Maths	Our Maths topics are: mass and capacity, fractions, money, time, geometry and statistics.
Science	Our science topic is light.
History	Our history topic is Ancient Greece.
PE	Lessons will continue with our specialist PE teacher. Mr Simpson They will be learning to play tennis and cricket.
Music	We will learn Bringing Us Together with our music teacher Mr Martin.
Art	In Art, we will be learning about Mythology. Within the lessons, the children will explore contemporary, traditional and modern art.
Religion	We are learning about founders of faith and Islam.
Computing	The children are learning about programming using Scratch.
PSHE	The children are learning about friendship and change.
Geography	Our geography units are Maps and South America.

### Knowledge Organisers—What are they? How do I use them?

Knowledge organisers are summaries of key facts and knowledge in topics prepared by the class teacher. They have the basic knowledge children will need to know in each topic. It would be most useful to talk through the knowledge organiser with your child, asking them what information is particularly interesting to them, and if they have any questions. Quiz your child on the information regularly.

## Bedrock and TTRS

### Bedrock

We ask our students to do around 10 minutes of Bedrock each day, to help them improve their reading, grammar and vocabulary. Please ask us if you would like a code to enable you to have your own Bedrock login so that you can track your child's progress.

### TTRS

Please encourage the regular use of TTRS - they should aim for 5 minutes each day. By the end of Year 3, your child should fluently know their 3s, 4s, and 8s, including division facts.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR THIS TERM

PE: Our class has PE on Tuesday.

Library: We visit the library every Wednesday. The children should bring their book to school everyday so that they always have a book to read.

Reading: Please make sure your child is reading for at least 20 minutes every day, and please sign their reading record. They can write the name of the book themselves, but any comments can be written by your child or by their adults.
