Communication and Language: As communicators, we will:

- Develop our communication using Makaton, visual aids and speech.
- Continue learning our classroom routines, using now and next boards, or using objects of reference.
- Learn and use story vocabulary.
- Sing a large repertoire of songs.

Mathematics: As mathematicians we will

- Develop counting-like behaviour, such as making sounds, pointing or saying some numbers in sequence.
- Link numerals and amounts: for example, showing the right number of objects to match the numeral, up to 5.
- Talk about and explore 2D shapes, for example, circles, rectangles, triangles, using informal and mathematical language: 'sides', 'corners'.
- Notice patterns and arrange things in patterns.
- Develop fast recognition of up to 3 objects, without having to count them individually ('subitising').

Physical Development: We will:

- Taste a variety of fruit that the Very Hungry Caterpillar ate, and learn about healthy eating.
- Eat efficiently and independently using spoon, fork and knife
- Continue to develop our fine-motor skills by using a range of tools competently, safely and confidently, e.g., scissors, paintbrushes and pencils.

Expressive Art and Design: As artists, we will:

- Make collage with natural resources: leaves, flowers, sticks, and with different textures of paper and fabric.
- Move and dance to music.
 - Role play our topic story.
